## **Description**

GoRaleigh will implement New Route 8-Six Forks Midtown as part of the frequent network. New Route 8-Six Forks replaces the current Six Forks route and splits into New Route 8 serving the inner portion (toward downtown Raleigh), and New Route 8L serving the outer portion. This route will continue to serve downtown Raleigh. New Route 16 will replace the Oberlin route and will no longer serve downtown Raleigh but will serve NC State University (NCSU). This route will be part of the frequent network, with transfers available to multiple other frequent routes and the Western Bus Rapid Transit line.
